

APPENDIX B: AREA LIGHT CONTRACT

Otsego Electric Cooperative, Inc. shall furnish, install, own, operate, and maintain a photoelectrically-controlled Area Light complete with a suitable pipe bracket at a location agreeable to both parties. Area lights may only be installed on an existing Service Pole or Transformer Pole.

Upon request by the member, the Cooperative shall change the location of the lightning unit, provided a proper support is furnished and the member pays the costs incurred in making such change.

The member shall notify the Cooperative office whenever the lamp shall become extinguished or out of service for any reason, and the Cooperative shall replace the lamp or make necessary repairs with reasonable promptness during regular business hours, Monday through Friday.

The member shall grant right-of-way access to the unit and pole to permit any tree trimming required to install and maintain the photoelectrically-controlled Area Light, charges may apply.

The member agrees that the unit, including the pole and conductors, may be removed at any time by the Cooperative upon failure by the member to pay the charges set forth in the Cooperative's rate schedule.

Further, the member agrees to protect the unit from damage so far as he/she is able and to pay for any willful or negligent damages done to the same. The contract is subject to cancellation in the event maintenance or lamp replacement become excessive due to vandalism or other causes.

If the member wishes to temporarily disconnect the unit a trip charge (Cooperative Fee & Rate Schedule) will be charged to disconnect the unit and charged to subsequently reconnect the unit.

The minimum period of this contract at the discretion of the member shall be: (Please check one option below)

- Four years (48 months), for which the member agrees to pay all charges as set forth.
- Two years (24 months), and a \$240 installation fee, for which the member agrees to pay all charges as set forth.

All contracts automatically renew upon their anniversary date of either two or four years, on a month-by-month basis unless the Cooperative has been notified to remove the unit upon the expiration date. If the Cooperative is notified to remove the unit prior to the anniversary date the member is responsible for paying the remaining months contracted. The unit as installed remains the property of the Cooperative.
